- During the winter, services are VERY limited, so always be prepared!





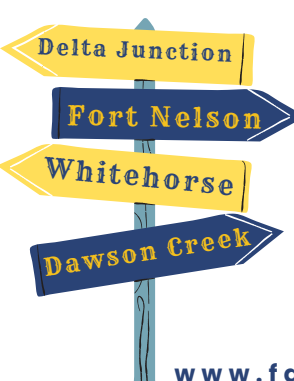
